

# Voting & Photo Identification

On Election Day, Alabama voters **must** present a photo ID to poll workers before they will be allowed to vote. Here are the types of identification accepted and how to apply for your photo ID.

## Alabama Driver License

Bring the following to your local DMV:

- Two forms of ID, at least one of which contains a photo
- Social Security Card
- School enrollment form or proof of graduation
- \$5 testing fee; \$36.25 purchase fee

## Alabama Nondriver License

Bring the following to your local DMV:

- Social Security Card
- Birth certificate or passport
- \$36.25 purchase fee

## Photo Voter ID Card **FREE**

If you do not have an Alabama driver/nondriver license or any ID form listed on the back of this guide, you can get a **FREE** voter photo ID at your local board of registrars office.

You must be registered to vote before you can get a photo voter ID card. Bring a document with your full name and date of birth to your board of registrars office.



## **OTHER ACCEPTED FORMS OF ID:**

- **Valid State-Issued ID**
  - **Examples (photo required):**
    - **Valid AL Dept. of Corrections Release ID**
    - **Valid AL Movement/Booking Sheet from Prison/Jail**
    - **Valid Pistol Permit**
- **Valid Federal-Issued ID**
- **Valid US Passport**
- **Valid Government Employee ID**
- **Valid University Student or Employee ID**
- **Valid Student or Employee ID**
  - **issued by any state institution of higher learning**
- **Valid Military ID**
- **Valid Tribal ID**
